Provincial Associations being those organizations having provincial jurisdiction over an equine breed, activity or interest may have representation on the Federation Board provided they will have met the following qualifications:

Article II, Section 2 D

- i. **Filed an application in writing recognizing the objectives and mandate of the Alberta Equestrian Federation Society** (*by submitting this application you are fulfilling this term*)
- ii. **Filed proof, satisfactory to the Board of Directors that the Association is organized democratically and represents and is recognized by the majority of the equine and equestrian associations and/or members within its terms of reference.** (*must submit bylaws of the association*)
- iii. **Filed proof that, if applicable, its national parent body recognizes it as the Provincial representative for the equine and equestrian activities within its terms of reference or by its members**
- iv. **Be registered under the Societies Act of the Province of Alberta unless prevented from doing so by the Bylaws of its National parent body** (*provide registration #*)
